

ASHLAND CITY COUNCIL
PLANNING MEETING
MARCH 26, 2018

The Ashland City Council met for a Planning Meeting on March 26, 2018 at 5:30 P.M. in the Ashland City Hall Auditorium with Mayor Larry J. Fetner presiding. Council Members present were Billy J. Smith, Bobbie J. Steed, Kim M. Cain, Annette F. Gaither, and Tommy Cantrell. Also present were City Clerk/ Administrator Chelsey Wynn, Assistant City Clerk/ Court Clerk Robin Catrett, Police Chief Joseph Stanford, Fire Chief Brett Thompson, Maintenance Supervisor Jody Brown, James Dawson, and Ray Stansell of the Clay Times Journal.

Items discussed included the interview procedure for the City of Ashland outlined in Resolution 02-06-01-2017, grants for sidewalks (all Council Members did not want to pursue at this time), the need for storm shelters within the city, road issues, surplusage of the Police Department 2005 Tahoe and the possibility of city employees using it for travel, draft beer, and regular meeting agenda items and additions.

Mayor Fetner advised he would like to send aide to Jacksonville, Alabama to help clean storm debris.

Fire Chief Brett Thompson updated the Council on the Fire Department rescue truck. Chief Thompson advised the truck is ready, but he is waiting to pick it to allow insurance to pay Long Lewis Ford \$13,197.22 for the repairs.
