PLANNING MEETING  
JUNE 04, 2018

The Ashland City Council met for a Planning Meeting on June 04, 2018 at 5:30 P.M. in the Ashland City Hall Auditorium with Mayor Pro Tempore Bobbie J. Steed presiding. Council Members present were Billy J. Smith, Kim M. Cain, Annette F. Gaither, and Tommy Cantrell. Also present were City Clerk/ Administrator Chelsey Wynn, Assistant City Clerk/ Court Clerk Robin Catrett, Police Chief Joseph Stanford, Maintenance Supervisor Jody Brown, Assistant Maintenance Supervisor Edward Waldrop, and Ray Stansell with The Clay Time Journal.

Mayor Larry J. Fetner and Fire Chief Brett Thompson were absent.

Items discussed included mosquitos in the Birding Trail, improvements for Ashland City Park and Recreation including a sports complex, and updates to the tennis courts. Also discussed were maintenance issues with current fencing at ball fields.

Council Member Cain requested information about the Lucas estate and gave an update on the Clay County Yellow-Meated Watermelon Festival.

City Clerk/ Administrator Chelsey Wynn advised the Council, at the request of Mayor Fetner, of possible grants available. City Clerk/ Administrator Wynn advised about road grants with a 20% match, fire truck grants with a 10% match, and recreational grants with 50% match.

Police Chief Stanford discussed the Police Department policies concerning presence at schools in their jurisdiction.
