ASHLAND CITY COUNCIL PLANNING MEETING AUGUST 17, 2020

The Ashland City Council met for a Planning Meeting on August 17, 2020 at 5:30 P.M. in the Ashland City Hall Auditorium with Mayor Larry J. Fetner presiding. Council Members present were Billy J. Smith, Bobbie J. Steed, Kim M. Cain, Annette F. Gaither, and Tommy Cantrell. Also present were City Clerk/ Administrator Chelsey Wynn, Assistant City Clerk/Court Clerk Robin Catrett, Police Chief Joseph Stanford, Maintenance Supervisor Lester Robinson, Fire Chief Brett Thompson, and Tammy Andrews with the Clay Times Journal.

Items discussed included a request from Central High School to use city bleachers (city would need to help with delivery and pickup of bleachers) and the City of Ashland Transportation Plan.

Council Member Cantrell advised Youth Sports has decided not to have a soccer season, and basketball season may also be cancelled depending on participation from other Youth Sports Programs.

Mayor Fetner reminded everyone that election day is August 25, 2020 at the Wynn Building. Mayor Fetner also informed everyone of a CDBG Pre Bid conference call meeting to be held on September 3, 2020 at 10:00 A.M. at City Hall and a bid opening for CDBG to be held September 10, 2020 at 10:00 A.M. at City Hall.

Maintenance Supervisor Robinson discussed regular meeting agenda items including Resolutions connected to the CDBG Project.

Mayor Fetner and Council Members discussed Mr. David Davis' request to host a revival at the City Park. Everyone agreed that, if Mr. Davis will practice social distancing and CDC recommendations, the event could take place.

Chief Stanford explained the resignation of Officer Dustin McGraw to join the Alabama State Troopers.
