

PLANNING MEETING
ASHLAND CITY COUNCIL
OCTOBER 15, 2018

The Ashland City Council met for a Planning Meeting and Public Hearing on October 15, 2018 at 5:30 P.M. in the Ashland City Hall Auditorium with Mayor Larry J. Fetner presiding. Council Members present were Billy J. Smith, Bobbie J. Steed, Kim M. Cain, Annette F. Gaither, and Tommy Cantrell. Also present were City Clerk/Administrator Chelsey Wynn, Assistant Police Chief/Investigator Corey Dickinson, Maintenance Supervisor William Robinson, Fire Chief Brett Thompson, Don Riley, Joanne Butler arrived at 5:52 P.M. and Justin McCullers of the Clay Times Journal.

Mayor Fetner stated that this was a public hearing and asked the council if they had any questions for land owner representative Don Riley.
