WHEREAS: The Hazard Mitigation Plan is required to be approved by the City of Ashland to maintain eligibility for pre and post disaster Hazard Mitigation Grant funds administered by FEMA; and

WHEREAS: The Ashland City Council recognizes the vulnerability of its resources, property and operation to the impacts of disasters and emergencies; and

WHEREAS: The Clay County Emergency Management Agency contracted with Lee Helms Associates to create a Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan for Clay County and the municipalities within the county; and

WHEREAS: By adopting a Hazard Mitigation Plan, the Ashland City Council will help ensure the long-term viability of the city and lessen the effects to the city from recurring damage due to natural hazards; and

WHEREAS: FEMA has reviewed the updated plan and determined the document meets all planning requirements.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASHLAND CITY COUNCIL, that the 2016 Clay County Hazard Mitigation Plan be adopted to serve as the Local Hazard Mitigation Plan for Ashland, Alabama.
