ASHLAND CITY COUNCIL PLANNING MEETING DECEMBER 16, 2019

The Ashland City Council met for a Planning Meeting on December 16, 2019 at 5:00 P.M. in the Ashland City Hall Auditorium with Mayor Larry J. Fetner presiding. Council Members present were Billy J. Smith, Bobbie J. Steed, Kim M. Cain, Annette F. Gaither, and Tommy Cantrell. Also present were City Clerk/Administrator Chelsey Wynn, Assistant City Clerk/Court Clerk Robin Catrett, Police Chief Joseph Stanford, Fire Chief Brett Thompson, Maintenance Supervisor Lester Robinson, Assistant Police Chief Chase Jordan, Representative Steve Hurst, and Tammy Andrews with the Clay Times Journal (17:37).

Items discussed included Mayor/Council salaries, meetings attended by Council Members, the upcoming Municipal Advocacy Meeting, monetary donations for Central High School of Clay County, and the Athletic Club road block.

Mayor Fetner addressed confusion surrounding the 5A State Championship Celebration on the square. Mayor Fetner advised it was not a city event, but made it clear the City of Ashland has no issue with the Celebration.

Maintenance Supervisor Lester Robinson updated the Mayor and Council on barrier issues on Gaither Cline Road. Supervisor Robinson advised ALDOT dropped the ball and will correct the issue by placing a permanent barrier once the contractor has completed the project. Supervisor Robinson advised in the mean time a temporary road closed sign has been placed on Gaither Cline Road.

Supervisor Robinson also advised the Mayor and Council of an incident involving the Central High School Fishing team on Lay Lake this past weekend. Supervisor Robinson advised a boating accident occurred involving another fishing team, and a team from Central High School stepped up to give assistance to those involved in the accident.
