

ASHLAND CITY COUNCIL
PLANNING MEETING
DECEMBER 20, 2021

The Ashland City Council met for a Planning Meeting on Monday, December 20, 2021 at 5:15 P.M. in the Ashland City Hall Auditorium with Mayor Larry J. Fetner presiding. Council Members present were Dianne Ballard, Bobbie J. Steed, Kim M. Cain, Annette F. Gaither, and Tommy Cantrell. Also present were City Clerk/Administrator Chelsey Wynn, Assistant City Clerk/Court Clerk Robin Catrett, Assistant Police Chief Tony Hubbard, Maintenance Supervisor Phillip Stinson, Parks & Recreation/Youth Sports Director Raquil Ward, Fire Chief Brett Thompson, and Ray Stansell with the Clay Times Journal.

Items discussed included the 2021 Christmas Parade and Mayor Fetner asked each Council Member to make some notes on how to make the parade event better, and requested planning for the event to begin earlier in the year possibly May 2022.
