RE: **Replacement of Traffic Signal Pole**

As per your request, Stone & Sons Electrical is pleased to offer a proposal for the replacement of the traffic signal pole at the corner of Highway 9 and Highway 77. We have included a new mast arm pole (black wet coat paint), bracket and light fixture, two new 3 section signals with backplates, moving the two existing signal heads back to the new mast arm, and the required signal wire and power wire. We have also included time to check the wiring at the signal pole for wire going on to the streetlights on the same side of the road that are not burning. If our technicians, on site, can determine what needs to be done to get power to the streetlights, we will quote pricing for that work, at that time.

Our price for this work is \$52,957.10.

We are assuming that the bolts that are anchoring the temporary pole can be used to anchor the new pole, and that the existing conduit is usable and sufficient to get any needed wiring from the controller to the new pole. We have not included any trenching, boring across the road, or new conduit in our pricing. We have not included any work to the existing traffic loops.

Pricing on the pole is valid for 30 days from this quote, with release for production within 60 days. Delivery can be made 25-26 weeks after release.
