PLANNING MEETING

The Ashland City Council met for a Planning Meeting on September 16, 2019 at 5:30 P.M. in the Ashland City Hall Auditorium with Mayor Larry J. Fetner presiding. Council Members present were Billy J. Smith, Bobbie J. Steed, Kim M. Cain, Annette F. Gaither, and Tommy Cantrell. Also present were City Clerk/Administrator Chelsey Wynn, Assistant City Clerk/ Court Clerk Robin Catrett, Police Chief Joseph Stanford, Maintenance Supervisor Lester Robinson, K9 Officer Adam Otwell, Lilly Otwell, and Tammy Andrews.

Fire Chief Brett Thompson was absent.

Items discussed included regular meeting agenda items, an opportunity to purchase a storm shelter, the First Responders Dinner, an advertisement with *At Home in Clay County* magazine, and scarecrows for the square.

Police Chief Stanford gave his committee report prior to the regular meeting due to a prior engagement during the regular meeting. Chief Stanford reported all the security cameras have been installed, the Police Cadets are doing well at the Police Academy, and a lack of bids for the Chevrolet Impala that has been deemed surplus. Chief Stanford also discussed regular meeting agenda items to include a request to purchase firearms for the Police Department. Chief Stanford explained the 9mm firearms would be more cost efficient due to the cost of ammunition.

Mayor Fetner commended local law enforcement on their efforts to keep the local school safe.
