The Ashland City Council met for a planning meeting on February 06, 2017 at 5:30 P.M. in the Ashland City Hall auditorium, with Mayor Larry J. Fetner presiding. Mayor Fetner updated the council on potential projects that will could be completed over the next four years including renovations of Ashland Police Department, foundation at old city hall, urban park bricks, old southland project, road repairs, street lights, storm shelters, and the sale of the current water department building.
