

**ORDINANCE NO. 2022-04-18-01**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ASHLAND, ALABAMA, TO EXEMPT CERTAIN “COVERED ITEMS” FROM THE MUNICIPAL SALES AND USE TAX DURING THE FIRST FULL WEEKEND OF AUGUST, AS AUTHORIZED BY ACT 2006-574, GENERALLY REFERRED TO AS THE BACK-TO-SCHOOL SALES TAX HOLIDAY LEGISLATION.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF ASHLAND, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. In conformity with the provisions Act 2006-574 enacted by the Alabama Legislature during the 2006 Regular Session, providing for a State Sales Tax Holiday, the Town of Ashland, Alabama, exempts “covered items” from municipal sales and use tax during the same period, beginning at 12:01 a.m. on the third Friday in July 2022, July 15, 2022, and ending at twelve midnight the following Sunday, **and each year thereafter until rescinded.**

Section 2. This ordinance shall be subject to all terms, conditions, definitions, time periods, and rules as provided by Act 2006-574.

Section 3. The Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this ordinance under the seal of the Town of Ashland, Alabama, and to forward said certified copy to the Alabama Department of Revenue to be recorded and posted on the Department website.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective on May 09, 2022.
