PLANNING MEETING  
MARCH 15, 2021

The Ashland City Council met for a Planning Meeting on March 15, 2021 at 5:00 P.M. in the Ashland City Hall Auditorium with Mayor Larry J. Fetner presiding. Council Members present were Dianne Ballard, Bobbie J. Steed, Kim M. Cain, Annette Gaither, and Tommy Cantrell. Also present were City Clerk/Administrator Chelsey Wynn, Assistant City Clerk/Court Clerk Robin Catrett, Police Chief Joseph Stanford, Maintenance Supervisor Phillip Stinson, Fire Chief Brett Thompson (5:21 P.M.), and Tammy Andrews with the Clay Times Journal.

Items discussed included Council visions for the City of Ashland, trees on right of way of 4<sup>th</sup> Street that need to be removed, bids for Lucas Property next to Urban Park, lot next to City Hall and potential grant opportunities, future of the Youth Sports Program and securing stability and security in the Youth Sports Department, and upcoming road projects.

Mayor Fetner advised the City of Ashland did not receive the first round of Rebuild Alabama Grant funds, but the City may still receive the second round of funding in May.

Mayor Fetner commended the Maintenance Department for work in Ashland Cemetery.

Council Member Cain thanked the Maintenance Department on behalf of the Arts League for working on their office.
