SPLASH PAD RULES

Open Annually Memorial Day through Labor Day

Monday-Sunday from 9am-8pm

Weather Dependent -open on weekends only after Labor Day and through

the end of September

(closed through noon on Wednesday for cleaning/maintenance)

To activate the splash pad, tap the activator button, the yellow pole with green top. The water automatically turns off after 15 minutes.

- Use of splash pad is prohibited during severe or dangerous weather
- All persons using the splash pad do so at their own risk
- Children MUST have adult supervision at all times
- Swimsuits and/or appropriate attire must be worn at all times
- Swim diapers are required for children ages 3 and under
- Urinating is prohibited on the splash pad
- Food and drinks are prohibited on the splash pad
- Running and Horseplay is prohibited on the splash pad
- Drinking water from the splash pad is prohibited
- Do not cover/block water fixtures, drains, or spray spigots
- Sitting, standing, climbing, or hanging on equipment/fixtures is prohibited
- Do NOT play with the green button
- Pets are prohibited
- Bicycles, scooters, and skateboards are prohibited
- In order to keep our patrons safe and the areas as clean as possible at all times, the splash pad may close at any given time due to unforeseen circumstances, such as mechanical or operational issues

Any person violating these instructions or rules may be asked to sit out for a period of time or be removed from the splash pad

*The splash pad is being continuously monitored by a live feed camera at all times.
